Evaluation of coaches:

- Do coaches follow safety rules and communicate them clearly to children? Coaches respected the rules of conduct and safety. Communication with the athletes was efficient, the competition atmosphere was positive, there was support from the coaches and the audience.
- Coaches are attentive to the children and respond promptly to their needs? The coaches were attentive to the needs of the children and made sure they had a positive experience at this competition.
- Do the coaches encourage and support the children in a positive way? The coaches were always there for the athletes, supporting their performances and providing emotional support throughout the day.

Evaluation of accommodation conditions:

- Is the accommodation clean and safe? Children need to be accommodated in safe and healthy conditions, that allow them to rest and prepare properly for the competition. Nearly all clubs participating in this competition have made a one-day trip, so there was no need to accommodate the athletes.
 - Are the children properly supervised?

Yes, the children were constantly and properly supervised. There were no medical or food incidents.

• Are there sufficient sanitary and personal hygiene facilities?

Yes, the conditions provided by the Pitesti Arena hall were up to hygiene and safety standards.

• Is the competition site clean and safe?

Yes, the competition venue was clean and safe.

Yes, the event benefited from the presence of a generous number of volunteers ready to assist if needed.

There were no slippery, uneven surfaces or other obstacles

Yes. The event had sufficient volunteers.

Yes, there is an evacuation plan in the hall, there are fire extinguishers, the organisers ensure that there are evacuation plans in visible places.

• Is there ambulance and first aid medical staff?

Throughout the competition and during the training sessions, there is an ambulance crew and an ambulance present on site.

• All safety rules and procedures are followed by organisers, officials and participants? Yes, organisers, officials and participants strictly follow all required safety rules and procedures. This ensures a safe and secure environment for the event.
